Calera's Mt. Harlan Vineyards are located in the Gabilan Mountains 25 miles east of the Monterey Bay. The site was chosen for its limestone soils and ideal climate. At an average elevation of 2,200 feet, it is among the highest and coolest vineyard sites in California.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2022 vintage at Mt. Harlan stands as a testament to resilience and exceptional winemaking. Despite low yields, the wines crafted this year are extraordinary—robust, dynamic, and rich in concentrated flavors with perfectly balanced acidity. After much-needed winter rains revitalized the vineyards, an ideal summer nurtured the grapes to perfection, resulting in wines of remarkable quality and character. This vintage captures the essence of our terroir with unparalleled depth and elegance.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Crafted from our prized estate Viognier, grown at soaring elevations of 2,200 feet, this captivating wine opens with enticing aromas of orange zest and anise. On the palate, it reveals a harmonious blend of flavors, with notes of citrus peel and fresh, earthy minerality, leading to a round, well-structured finish.
